

PROCEDURE OF BS-INTERVIEW

The candidate must come to the college in uniform along with the following documents:

b. Photocopies Required

- (i) One attested copy of Character Certificate from the institution last attended. Private candidates are required to provide a Character Certificate attested by a gazetted officer not related to them.
- (ii) Three attested copies of each SSC and HSSC marks sheet.
- (iii) Three attested copies of B-form issued by NADRA.
- (iv) Attested photocopy of CNIC of parents (Father/mother)
- (v) One attested photocopy of pension book for retired personnel.

c. Original Documents required

- (i) Marks Sheet (SSC & HSSC).
- (ii) Character/provisional certificate.
- (iii) Pension book (for retired armed forces personnel)
- (iv) Service card (for serving armed forces personnel, FGEI (C/G) employees)
- (v) "B" Form (issued by NADRA) / CNIC of the student.
- (vi) Affidavit with a court stamp of the value of Rs. 20/- (blank perforated affidavit is given at the end of this prospectus)
- (vii) Affidavit with a court stamp of the value of Rs. 20/- regarding gap certificate for the applicants passing FA/F.Sc. before 2020
- (viii) Three recent photographs of size 1.5" x 2" and One photograph of size 1" x 1" (unattested). The candidate's name and father's name should be written on the back of the photographs.
